ITINERARY: MILAN, ITALY-ZERMATT, INTERLAKEN, AND LAUSANNE, SWITZERLAND

Monday, March 25- Milan, Italy to Zermatt, Switzerland: Private transfer to Milan Centrale Station. Depart on the first-class train from Milan to Zermatt via Brig. Zermatt is the resort city at the foot of the famous Matterhorn. Train ride is approximately 3 ½ hours. Check-in to Hotel Pollux (standard rooms) for two nights including breakfast daily. Afternoon and evening is at your leisure to explore the mountain village of Zermatt. **B**

Tuesday, March 26-Zermatt- Mount Gornergrat: Depart for a full day private guided excursion to Mount Gornergrat on cog railway 10,000 feet above sea level. The round-trip from Zermatt is approximately 2 ½ hours. This must-see panoramic view of the 29-mountain views of the Alps includes the Matterhorn, Monte Rosa, and Weisshorn, and the Gorner Glacier is spectacular. Evening is at your leisure. **B**

Wednesday, March 28- Zermatt to Interlaken via Lucerne: Depart Zermatt on the first-class Glacier Express train to Andermatt. This scenic train ride is approximately 3 hours over numerous bridges, mountain forests, and tunnels. We will continue from Andermatt on our private transfer for a 2-hour guided walking tour of scenic Lucerne. Check-in to the Interlaken Hotel with business class rooms. Breakfast is included daily. Evening is at your leisure. **B**

Thursday, March 29- Excursion from Interlaken to Mount Jungfrauoch & Grindelwald: Depart for a full day private tour to the heart of the Bernese Alps to the mighty "Eiger"-13,026 feet, Monch-13,449 feet, and the Jungfrau-13,643 feet above sea-level. We will walk to Interlaken Ost station and take the train to into the Waterfall Valley of Lauterbrunnen, where we will change and board the train to the Jungfrauoch, the highest railway station in Europe. There we will visit the Ice Palace and the Sphinx Terraces with beautiful views of the Aletsch Glacier, the largest glacier in the Alps. The train rides are approximately 2 ½ hours each way. Evening is at your leisure. **B**

Friday, March 30- Interlaken to Lausanne: We will depart Interlaken on the first-class Golden Pass Panoramic train from Interlaken to Zweisimmen where we will change trains to Montreux. Total train ride is approximately 3 ½ hours. Scenic sights along the way include mountain vistas, alpine meadows, small mountain villages, and vineyards. Tour to the Olympic Museum and entrance to Lausanne Cathedral is included. Our hotel during our stay in Lausanne-Ouchy is the five-star deluxe Beau-Rivage Palace located along the shores of Lake Geneva with views of the Savoy (French) Alps. Evening is at your leisure. **B**
